Battery Removal and Installation – Car

1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

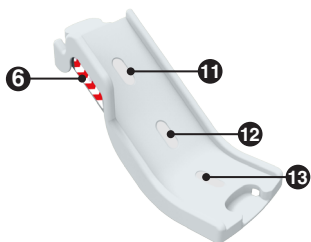
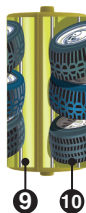
RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the VTech® Go! Go! Smart Wheels® Speedy Repair Shop™, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

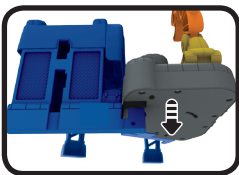
1. Follow steps A through C below to assemble the 2nd story track and attach it to the track supports and repair base :
 - A. Attach 2nd story track A to 2nd story track B. A clicking sound will confirm they are firmly connected.



- B. Flip the 2nd story track assembly upside down and insert the elevator wall, track support A and track support B into the slots on the 2nd story track until they make a clicking sound.



C. Attach the repair base to the 2nd story track assembly by inserting the repair base wall into the slots on the 2nd story track. Then insert one end of the elevator wall into the slot on the repair base. A clicking sound will confirm they are firmly connected.



2. Assemble the elevator by attaching the elevator track into the slots on the elevator wall, and then slide the elevator platform down the elevator track.

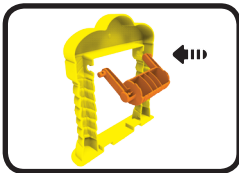


3. Insert the sign board, tire roller, display plate, gate and ramp track into the slots on the 2nd story track.





4. Insert the car wash roller onto the car wash entry, and connect the car wash entry assembly to the bottom of the ramp track.



Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to play! You can also connect the **Speedy Repair Shop** play set to other **Go! Go! Smart Wheels®** play sets (each sold separately).

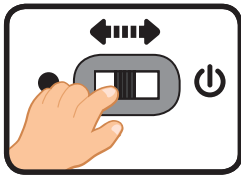


PRODUCT FEATURES

Sports Car

1. On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **On** (⏻) position.
To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** (●) position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the Sports Car will automatically power down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the light - up button, pushing the Sports Car quickly or triggering a SmartPoint™ location.

ACTIVITIES

Sports Car

1. Press the Light - Up Button to hear fun phrases, songs, sounds and melodies. While a melody is playing, continue pushing the Sports Car to add fun sounds on top of the melody. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Push the Sports Car to hear fun sounds and phrases. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Place the Sports Car on one of the play set's three SmartPoint™ locations to see the vehicle's light flash and to hear fun sounds, short tunes and phrases. The vehicle also interacts with other Go! Go! Smart Wheels® play sets (each play set sold separately).



ACTIVITIES

Repair Shop

1. Place the Sports Car or any SmartPoint™ vehicle (each sold separately) on any of the play set's three SmartPoint™ locations to hear fun sounds, music and phrases.



2. Place the Sports Car on the lift board SmartPoint™ to hear fun sounds and phrases. Lift the elevator to the top and release the vehicle to run down the track.



3. Block the Sports Car with the gate, then lift up the gate to let the vehicle run down through the car wash.



4. Place the Sports Car on the repair base, push and pull the joystick to move the vehicle and mechanical arm up and down. Move the joystick left and right to move the repair base and mechanical arm right and left. You will hear responses with fun sounds and phrases.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
